











Step by Step Butterfly Stiletto

	<p>Use Cleanse to sanitise hands Push cuticles with the spoon side of Magic Wand Use the bladed end to scrape away any protein growth Swipe all 10 nails and apply 2 coats of Protein Bond Apply your reverse bead to all 10 nails</p>
	<p>Refine smile line with Diamond File Apply forms and pinch to stiletto length and shape</p>
	<p>We are using Neon Blue and Metallic Dark Blue Imagination Art powder.</p>
	<p>Apply Neon Blue to the free edge very thinly and remembering to deposit your bead upside down as Neon colours are based on white.</p>
	<p>Apply a thin layer of Metallic Dark Blue around the smile line and fading in the Neon Blue</p>

	<p>When this has dried use Kaleidoscope Black to chase the smile line and make a ragged edge. Also paint the tip in black. I use a pointed Orangewood stick for this. Freeze in UV lamp.</p>
	<p>Add very fine veins using your Orangewood stick or a toothpick. Freeze.</p>
	<p>Using Kaleidoscope White and your Orangewood stick apply white dots to the smile line and free edge. Cure for 2 minutes.</p>
	<p>Cap with clear acrylic or Build gel. I have used gel in this picture.</p>
	<p>Remove forms and file using your I Formation Roadmap.</p>
	<p>Cleanse with Swipe and apply Finish Gel. Cure for 2 minutes and apply Rose Oil. You've just finished a killer stiletto!!!</p>
	<p>Experiment with different colours! This is Blushing Girl and Metallic Carmine.</p>
